

## REGISTRATION WITH A NURSE PRACTITIONER SPECIALIZED IN PRIMARY CARE

Information document

The nurse practitioner specialized in primary care (NPSPC) you are currently seeing is offering you the opportunity to become your treating professional. To accept, you must complete the **attached form**. This NPSPC is committed to taking you on as their patient and ensuring follow-up of your health problems.

Your follow-up includes the prescription of examinations or medication. If necessary, it includes requests for consultation with another NPSPC, general practitioner or medical specialist.
